

# RECENT UPGRADES TO TED 3.42

14<sup>th</sup> of May, 2007.

Since version 3.35 was release on the 14<sup>st</sup> of February 2007 a number of additional updates have been released. This document describes these recent updates.

## Recent Updates

The latest version of Ted is 3.42 and contains the following updates:

- Add **General History** report,
- Add Queensland Funding code **CPL Community Literacy Program**,
- Update Tasmanian Funding descriptions,
- Add **Year 13** for Tasmanian Vet in Schools,
- Add single student Exporting to TQA for Tasmanian Vet in Schools,
- Add filtering to AVETMISS exporting for New South Wales,
- Update Training Packages details from NTIS,
- Fix reporting of AVETMISS for WA.

## Tasmania – Single Student Export to TQA

Tasmanian Schools using Ted to report Vet in Schools information to TQA can now export a Single Student to XML.

## New South Wales – AVETMISS Exporting

There are three ways of exporting AVETMISS data in NSW:

- Single Trainee,
- Multiple Selected Trainees, or
- All Trainees with the same Course/Site code.

The first two methods now have a new option to select only one Course/Site code if the Trainee (or Trainees) are enrolled in multiple courses with more than one Course/Site code, Ted will automatically detect this case and ask which of the Course/Site codes you wish to export.

To export a **Single** Trainee:

1. bring up the Trainee Details screen,
2. select the Trainee you wish to export,
3. choose **Create Trainee Export** from the **Avetmiss** menu.

To export **Multiple** Trainees:

1. bring up the Trainee Details screen,
2. change the Show dropdown box at the top of the Trainee List from **Trainee(s)** to **Selected Trainee(s) to Print / Active**,
3. highlight one or more Trainees in the list using the Control key,
4. choose **Create Trainee Export** from the **Avetmiss** menu.

To export all trainees with the sample **Course/Site** code choose **Create Course/Site export** from the **Avetmiss** menu.
